<b>Objectives in spending PPF</b>	
<p>We are keen to narrow the achievement and attainment gaps between the students eligible for the pupil premium and their peers and so our total allocation of funds for the support of disadvantaged students is significantly higher than the pupil premium. The following areas were identified as priorities for narrowing the gaps between the students eligible for the pupil premium and their peers:</p>	
<p>1. Improving the quality of teaching and learning: by providing professional Speech and Language strategy delivery support for all teachers in order to embed speech and language strategies in all classrooms.</p>	
<p>2. Improving attainment and achievement</p> <p>KS4 qualifications: percentage of students making at least expected progress in English and maths.</p> <p>Years 7-9: percentage of students making at least expected progress in English and maths.</p>	
<p>3. Improving attendance: by prioritising interventions provided by the attendance officer to improve the attendance of pupil premium students through the use of outreach, family support and external provision</p> <p>Years 7-11: attendance</p> <p>Years 7-11: persistent absenteeism</p>	
<p>4. Improving emotional and mental health wellbeing:</p> <p>Through delivery of an intensive and well supported tiered mentoring programme, responsive to the individual needs of pupils through group and individual mentoring and therapy.</p>

Kingfisher is closing the gap in achievement between pupils who do not receive pupil premium and those who do through a variety of interventions, tailored to the complex individual needs of students in our cohort. These interventions are particularly effective in KS2 where all students in receipt of pupil premium funding are working at or above expected levels in both Literacy and Numeracy.
