We were very lucky to be able to visit Bumble Hole Foods in Bromsgrove. Prior to the visit we completed health & safety and medical questionnaires provided by the company. The visit started by all students stopping at the weighbridge and it was explained to the students that all lorries are weighed as they enter and leave so that they can account for all products. Students were asked to guess what the combined weight of them all plus staff would be. Next we were all kitted out in protective clothing, hair covers and shoe protection and the visit started through all processes of the plant. We were able to see where all the eggs are stored in huge cold rooms and more competitions took place to guess how many eggs are stored. Our tour allowed us to witness the egg separating machines, egg boilers and coolers as well as taking part in egg smashing activities. Towards the end of the visit refreshments were provided and a competition took place to whisk egg whites by hand. Students were handed an Amazon voucher on leaving as well as additional vouchers for those students who won all the individual competitions.
